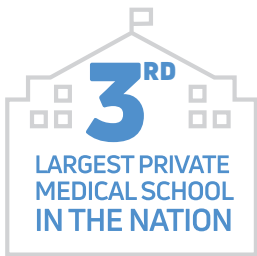

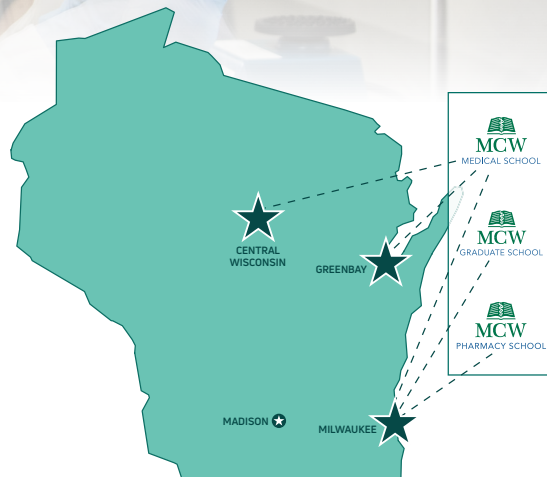
RECRUITED 6,900 INDIVIDUALS TO REGION OVER 10 YEARS
