Our fellowships have a particular focus on scholarly pursuits, and fellows are able to work with established mentors in their fields who encourage and assist their research endeavors and provide valuable feedback. Fellows' research efforts are also supported and guided by members of the Scholarly Oversight Committees.

At NewYork-Presbyterian/Columbia, pediatric fellows benefit from exposure to a wide variety of patients and conditions across care settings. This provides a solid foundation in clinical care as well as experience caring for some of the most acute and complex patients in the world. Fellows take ownership of their patients and are well supervised and given progressive autonomy. To complement their clinical learning, the department has a well-established tradition of encouraging fellows to participate in local and national activities, and offers fellows an array of conferences, journal clubs, research opportunities, and core educational seminars in addition to the curriculum within their specific programs.

Each spring, senior fellows are invited to submit their research for consideration for research awards. All of the senior fellows present their work at a poster session, attended by faculty and fellows, and those whose work is particularly outstanding are awarded the Oberfield Prizes in Basic, Translational and Clinical Research.

The Department of Pediatrics remains deeply committed to helping talented young physicians develop their academic careers and takes great pride in watching the progress of the department's graduates.
