CARDIOVASCULAR

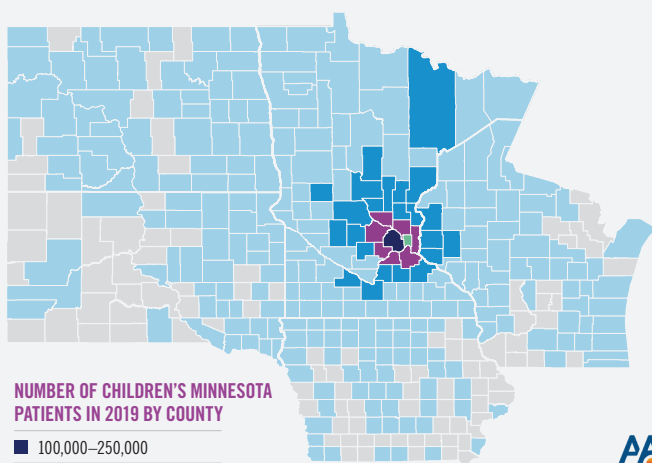
Providing comprehensive cardiac services from before birth into adulthood, performing 450+ surgeries annually.
